

Create with Clorox Fabric Designing

Description

In this lively class students create their own designs on fabrics using assorted bleaching techniques. A number of techniques will be tried in class and each student will be taking home pieces of original design, one of kind fabrics to use in future quilt creations. Class is best held in an outdoor environment or a well ventilated class space. Access to water is necessary. Come ready to experiment and have fun!

Supply List

- **Fabric-** Bring the equivalent of approximately two yards (some will finish more, some less, depending on the techniques and designs chosen). Natural fibers work best. This can be solid color, tone on tone, or print. Over-saturated, dark colors seem to work the best- (I have had good luck with Kona cotton solids) though interesting results can come from many fabrics. **It is difficult to predict the results so it is best to bring an assortment of fabric rather than all one kind.** The pieces should be large enough to accommodate the desired design with some space around it to serve as the background. Fat quarters are a good size.
- **Design ideas-** Designs will be supplied in class, but you can bring any other patterns that you might like to try. The designs can be of any size, so long as they will fit on your chosen fabrics. Cookie cutters, stamps, coloring books, stencils, or applique designs that would be traditionally appliqued with fabric all work well.



- **Pencil**
- **Scissors**- paper (with sharp points to cut details) and fabric
- **Masking Tape**
- **A couple of OLD towels**
- **Optional-rubber gloves**
- **Plastic to cover work surface** (a garbage bag would work)
- *note-chlorine bleach products are used in class, it is optional but advisable to wear a breathing mask and eye protection
 - **WEAR OLD CLOTHES-WE WILL BE WORKING WITH BLEACH !!!**
- **Medium to Large "Ziploc" type plastic bags**- to carry damp fabric pieces from class
- **\$4.00 kit fee** (I will be supplying all bleaching products and "utensils" needed)
- **Roll of paper towels**
- Two or three irons are needed for **entire class**. Check with host of class to see if they will be provided.
